

The 2010 Ohio Police and Fire Games

— *Entry Fee Information* —

Entry fee is \$40.00 per person for the first individual sport (not including team sports) which includes the primary event and 2 additional events within that sport (with a few exceptions, see event descriptions for details). There is a \$5.00 fee for each additional event within that sport beyond the included 3 events. Participation in an additional sport is \$10.00 per sport. See next two pages for breakdown of fees.

Additional or special fees apply in certain sports including but not limited to 3-D Archery, Bowling, Golf, Racquet Ball, Sporting Clays, Skeet, and Trap. Refer to the descriptions of sports in this Registration Application booklet for more detailed information as some sports include more than one event. Contact Event Coordinator for details. Some rules will be posted at the website; coordinators will determine additional/other rules for their event.

Medals will be awarded to individuals and doubles placing 1st, 2nd and 3rd. In team sports there will be a team trophy for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places.

TEAM SPORTS

Team sports are basketball (mens and womens), ice hockey, softball, and indoor soccer. Entry fees for team sports: ***basketball/mens*** – \$250.00, 12-person team; ***basketball/womens 3-on-3*** – \$125.00, 6-person team; ***ice hockey*** – \$500.00; ***softball*** – \$300.00, 20-person team; ***indoor soccer*** – \$200.00, 20-person team.

A completed team roster MUST be filled out by the team captain and filed with team captain's registration application, along with an ***application filled out by each member of the team***. **TEAM CAPTAINS: be sure ALL of your team members check in at the command post BEFORE your event begins.** In the event you have not mailed each player's application, they will need to bring the completed forms to the command post.

Eligible substitutions will be allowed to register at check in. Any team that brings or has a player who is not eligible will be disqualified and will jeopardize its department's participation for two years.

ABSOLUTE CUT-OFF DATE TO REGISTER FOR TEAMS: JUNE 1, 2010.

NOTE:

Entry fee MUST accompany registration application. Completed team roster MUST accompany application registration or team will not be allowed to participate. ALL forms are included in this booklet. Team participants may be asked to show ID prior to the beginning of the game; if requested, ID must be shown in order to participate.

TEAM SPORTS

PARTICIPATION IN ADDITIONAL SPORTS

* Weight Pentathlon is treated as one event. Points are added from the 5 events, and medals are awarded to the 3 highest cumulative point holders; must pay additional fee of \$5.
